



Hudson Highlands Fjord Trail

The Breakneck Ridge trail is one of the most popular trails in New York State Parks. It is one of the only rugged challenging scramble hikes with a rewarding iconic view of the Hudson River Valley that is accessible by public transportation. The new Breakneck Upper Overlook area at the start of the trail and the Nimham Trail have already dramatically improved the Breakneck trail matrix.
