



To clarify for those who are not aware, estimates by OPRHP have current visitation to the Hudson Highlands State Park Preserve at 480,000 annually, so the projected increase in visitation from the Fjord Trail would be 120,000 over the course of a year starting in 2028. Taking into consideration the additional infrastructure and services HHFT will provide, visitation impacts (from both existing and new users of the trail) such as trash accumulation should be mitigated rather than exacerbated. Visitation data is currently being analyzed and may lend itself to answering your question further. Please stay tuned.
