With a thoughtfully considered visitation management strategy in place and improved infrastructure and services, the Village will be in a better situation than it is in today, in terms of handling the impacts of existing and future visitation. Hikers who arrive to Cold Spring by train will be able to move quickly and efficiently to the trail and not contribute to the existing congestion on Village streets that occurs during high visitation weekends. Public restrooms at Dockside Park will better serve visitors who currently linger at the Visitor Kiosk at the foot of Main Street or beg to use Main Street businesses restrooms. HHFT staff will manage trash and recycling collection and landscaping tasks in Dockside Park, relieving Village staff of the burden of maintaining the park. Organized parking areas, an improved Breakneck train station, and a Visitor Center at Dutchess Manor will all draw hikers north before they even arrive on Main Street. The comprehensive visitor management strategy will include ways to nimbly respond to the number of visitors, including measures such as timed entry and/or redirection to other entry points on the trail.
