



Hudson Highlands Fjord Trail

With a thoughtfully considered visitation management strategy in place and improved infrastructure and services, the Village will be in a better situation than it is in today in terms of the impacts of visitation. Hikers who arrive by train at Cold Spring will be able to move quickly and efficiently to the trail and not contribute to the existing congestion on Village streets that occurs during high visitation weekends. Public restrooms, planned for Dockside Park, will better serve visitors who currently linger at the Visitor Kiosk at the foot of Main Street or beg to use Main Street businesses restrooms. Staff available to manage trash and recycling collection and landscaping tasks in Dockside Park will also relieve Village staff of the burden of maintaining the park. Organized parking areas, an improved Breakneck train station, and a Visitor Center at Dutchess Manor will all draw hikers north before they even arrive on Main Street.
