Fjord Trail

The 7.5-mile main trail between Beacon and Cold Spring is envisioned with six main access points to help distribute visitors along the entire span of the Fjord Trail. The Visitor Center at Dutchess Manor will strategically draw hikers away from Cold Spring by serving as the Fjord Trail's welcoming and orienting hub, providing restrooms, food options, a large amount of parking, and educational programming. Combined, both the increased number of entry points and the Visitor Center location, just north of Breakneck, are designed to provide Cold Spring with some much-needed relief to current and growing visitation pressure. Without the Fjord Trail, the congestion may continue to worsen.
