



That poster states that 35% are projected to come by train with predicted transit shifts. However, HHFT, in partnership with the NYNJ Trail Conference stewards and HHFT's expert consultant team, have been conducting a number of on-site and QR-code surveys of visitors to Breakneck to better understand the ages, group sizes, zip codes, and mode of arrival to inform our planning. We are also seeking to understand where a Breakneck hiker may go before or after their hike today. Gathering this information will help us understand how hikers might behave when they have more choices to walk or take the shuttle to locations currently inaccessible (e.g., Dutchess Manor, Notch, Beacon).
