Correct. Master Plans contain only very high-level (not even schematic-level) details. Their goal is to provide enough information on the location, scale, and components of the project to inform both the environmental review and future design work. As we move beyond the Draft Master Plan, actual design happens in specific intervals - concept, 30%, 60%, 80% and 100%. In the early stages of design development, site conditions are documented including topography, boundaries, hydrology, and geotechnical information. As design advances to construction drawings, the drawing sets contain an increasing level of specificity and detail on such things as railings, landscape material, etc. The Breakneck Connector and Bridge are at 100% design. The Shoreline Trail is (as of September 2023) at the concept design stage. The drawings will not be shared publicly for the bridge until it is publicly bid out for construction by the State of New York.
