Hudson Highlands Fjord Trail

No one from HHFT has ever claimed that any aspect of the project would have "zero impact." Everything (and everyone) has some impact on habitat, from the cars driving by, to the vibrations from the trains, to the air traffic overhead, to seasonal fireworks displays. Studies undertaken as part of the Breakneck Connector FEAR (lead agency: OPRHP with additional review by NYS DEC) concluded that impacts on habitat were not significant enough to warrant intervention or mitigation. Still, safeguards to protect threatened/special concern species were in place when work on the Upper Overlook occurred and the resulting closure of social trails has actually reduced habitat disturbance. The Breakneck FEAR is part of the public record.

The Generic Environmental Impact Statement will explore what impacts the rest of the Fjord Trail could have on various habitats and whether/what types of mitigation or alterations will be needed.
